Research-Related Activities
These Institutes are part of a comprehensive, two-part research project:  Part 1 is an Implementation Study to examine the ways that program leaders incorporate BEETLES
materials into their programs. Every program accepted into a BEETLES Institute is encouraged to take
part in this research through surveys of program leaders and education staff and, potentially, other research-related activities. The maximum research-related time commitment for program leaders is 6
hours over the course of a year and, for field instructors, 3 hours. All programs will be asked to participate in the Implementation Study.
Part 2 is an Efficacy Study to examine the extent to which outdoor learning experiences impact science learning activation and environmental literacy among students. Starting in 2019, 50 participating programs
will be randomly selected to participate. This study will require program leaders to administer student surveys before, during, and after a program to 25 total students. Our research team will coordinate these
research related activities. The maximum research-related time commitment for students in this study is
1hr, 40 minutes. For field instructors, it is 30 minutes. The only requirement of program leaders in this study is to support coordination of data collection.
The research team will reach out to participating leaders to further describe the research and what may be asked of you.
